



USD 369 Educator's Scholarship  
Eligibility and Criteria



- 1) The recipient must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or above.
- 2) The recipient must have attended Burrton High School for the junior and senior years.
- 3) Applications will be judged on the following: (1) the amount and quality of school/community service and (2) an essay describing career/educational goals and plans to achieve those goals.
- 4) The USD 369 Educator's will award one scholarship each year. The scholarship is for one year only and is to be used for the fall semester following high school graduation.
- 5) Any graduating senior wishing to be considered for the scholarship must submit a completed application to the school counselor by April 18<sup>th</sup>.
- 6) Selection of the recipient will be made by a group of five USD 369 educators appointed by the high school principal. The school counselor will aid the committee in an advisory capacity.
- 7) Announcement of the recipient will be made at the Burrton High school Spring Awards.
- 8) Payment of the scholarship will be made to the recipient and postsecondary institution.
