The School

Burrton High School is a four year school that is accredited by the Kansas Department of Education. Burrton has experienced continuous growth as new updates populate the school. In 2015 a bond was passed to update many existing structures, including a paved parking lot, new gym bleachers, and a resurfaced track. The academic year is 167.5 days long. The day is divided into eight periods of 53 minutes in length with an MTSS(Multi-Tiered System of Support) period which meets for 33 minutes daily. There are four terms in the school year in which students take seven classes a term.

Grading Scale

Letter grades of A, B, C, D, F are given in all subjects. D is the lowest passing mark. Each course gets a half point (.5) per semester, with MTSS gaining an additional quarter credit (.25). Our grades are based on a 4.0 scale: A= 100-90%, B=89-80%, C=79-70%, D=69-60%, F=59-0%
